

Remote Learning at Gloverspiece School

At Gloverspiece we make every attempt to be flexible and provide personalised learning opportunities for all our pupils that are adapted to their individual circumstances and needs. All our children require one to one support within school and our remote learning package is designed to reflect this. During periods of remote learning we will offer a variety of activities including:

- Daily morning chat online session to start the day.
- Daily outdoor learning lessons to support both mental health and physical health. The lessons are both fun and cross-curricula including; art, maths, science, fine and gross motor skills
- Land-based learning project for Secondary children to encourage independent learning.
- Animal project accessible to all children and intended to engage those children who struggle to access traditional lessons.
- Daily afternoon shared story online session to draw the day to a close.
- Weekly social online nurture sessions – to ensure that children maintain contact with their peers and to support mental well-being.
- Weekly social online catch-up sessions with their support worker again to maintain contact and to support mental well-being
- Differentiated Maths learning packs aimed at consolidation and practise of subjects already covered in class.
- Differentiated Spelling learning packs.
- Differentiated Reading Comprehension packs again aimed at consolidating and practising skills already experienced in class.
- Weekly links to maths, literacy, science, history, art and geography online games, websites and activities.
- Music, RE and Internet Safety learning packs including lesson ideas, activities and links to interactive games/websites.
- Weekly family farm sessions (weather permitting)
- Individualised learning programmes where children are unable to participate in group sessions or are absent from school for extended periods.

If any children or parents are experiencing difficulties during periods of remote learning, please contact the school, as we will endeavour to provide any support that is required including personalised learning packages.
